SUBJECT: PRESENTATION BY MONROE COUNTY REGARDING US 1 MASTER PLAN STUDY

At the Village Council meeting of November 18, 2021, representatives of Monroe County will present the Transportation Master Plan for US 1 (TMP) adopted by the Monroe County Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) on October 20, 2021, and the top 15 TMP projects as selected by the BOCC on November 3, 2021.

As the lead transportation agency in our community, Monroe County is seeking feedback from all of the county's municipalities on its TMP and its priorities in the hopes that each municipality will support those priorities and identify up to ten of their own, thereby allowing the County and municipalities to present, and advocate for, a united Florida Department of Transportation work program. The staff and I are generally supportive of this approach and would suggest that the Council digest this presentation and then develop its recommendations and priority list at one or more subsequent Council meetings. Accordingly, if it is acceptable to the Council, we will schedule this matter for further discussion at the Special Call Meeting of December 2 and, as necessary, for the Regular Meeting of December 16.

As you may recall, the TMP is over 700 pages. Therefore, rather than distribute it as part of the packet, the file is available from the Village Clerk's Office upon request. Attached, please find the BOCC Agenda Item of November 3, 2021, which provides an excellent synopsis and the BOCC's top 15 projects.
